In order to assist in the review of Registered Counselling Therapist – Candidate (RCT-C) applications, the NSCCT has adopted the practice of expediting the process for applicants who have graduated from Canadian Accreditation of Counselling Education Programs (CACEP) accredited graduate degree programs.

Graduating from a listed program does not guarantee registration, but is intended only to eliminate a part of the application that is known to be satisfied by meeting CACEP standards. Applicants graduating from the listed graduate programs will not normally be required to complete Sections C (*Practicum Description Form*, F-02.1) or D (*NSCCT Required Courses*) of the *Registered Counselling Therapist-Candidate Application* (F-02.0). All other application requirements will remain in effect.

The Registration Committee will be responsible for overseeing the updating of the list on a bi-annual basis to ensure currency. The list is considered complete only at the date of its last update, and may be revised without notice by the Registrar.
