### POLICY

Licensed registrants shall maintain a minimum one million dollars (\$1,000,000) of professional liability insurance.

Proof of insurance must be submitted with all applications for licensure and at the time of annual license renewal.

Proof of insurance may be in the form of a copy of the current policy, a letter from the insurer, or a letter from the registrant's employer confirming coverage in the amount required by the College.

### PURPOSE

To ensure all Registrants have sufficient means to indemnify a member of the public if required.

To ensure Registrants are in compliance with the *Counselling Therapists Act 12.1(f)*.
