



Preapproved Supervisor Education

Introduction

As per policy ***Candidacy Supervision***, prior to supervising NSCCT licensed RCT-Candidates, a Registered Counselling Therapist must:

- Have their name appear in the Active Practicing Roster of the College
- Have a minimum of two (2) years post-candidacy counselling experience
- Provide proof acceptable to the Executive Director/Registrar that they have completed a clinical supervision educational program as prescribed by the Board or a program deemed equivalent.
- Hold and maintain Professional Liability Insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000, and an aggregate amount not less than \$5,000,000 with no deductible. This insurance must also include coverage for supervising trainees.
- Be approved by the Executive Director/Registrar prior to entering into a contract with an RCT-Candidate to provide supervision services, and must not be,
 - a family member or relative of the candidate,
 - an employer, manager, or contractor of the candidate during the duration of the supervisor-candidate alliance

Supervisor Education Standard

The NSCCT standard for supervisor education is the ***Introductory Supervision Seminar*** developed and offered on an occasional basis by the Acadia University MEd program in response to the needs of the College. The following list of preapproved supervisor education programs has been assessed as meeting or exceeding this standard.

Schedule of Preapproved Supervisor Education Programs

In alphabetical order by institution:

1. Acadia University

- Introductory Supervision Seminar
- Intermediate Supervision Seminar (optional)

Note: Only the Introductory Supervision Seminar or equivalent is required to supervise NSCCT candidates. Those who wish to move beyond the introductory level are strongly encouraged. Acadia also offers an *Intermediate Supervision Seminar* for current supervisors.
